

WHITE

Mountbridge Chardonnay, *Riverina, Australia*

Quite a deep straw colour with plenty of bouncy stone fruit flavours; plump nectarine, apricot and peach. A ripe, quite full-bodied off dry white.

Cortefresca Pinot Grigio DOC, *Veneto, Italy*

Fresh and fruity, with light notes of wild flowers, light balanced and persistent. Good fruity notes and slight aromatic return.

Domaine de La Baume 'Elizabeth' Viognier, *Languedoc, France*

Established two centuries ago at Beziers in Languedoc and renowned for its winemaking expertise, La Baume proposes this fresh and fruity white wine with citrus, peach and apricot flavours.

Lawson's Dry Hills Sauvignon Blanc, *Marlborough, New Zealand*

Pronounced passionfruit together with fresh herbs, fruit salad and floral aromas lead to an intense, fruit-driven palate. This wine is certified sustainable and carbon zero.

Bergsig Estate Chenin Blanc, *Breedekloof, South Africa*

A dry, full-bodied crisp wine with a tang of guava fruit, soft honey overtones and a lasting finish.

Pionero Albarino, *Rias Baixas, Spain*

The aromas perceptible include certain vegetable tones, blending in perfectly with a variety of fruity notes, particularly citrus and stone fruits, as well as lemon verbena and mint. The palate exhibits moderate acidity, a fine balance adding crispness while maintaining its marked complexity.

Bel Air Signature Macon Villages, *Burgundy, France*

Light golden colour with bright green tones. Floral and fruity aromas of lemon, lychee, grapefruit and pineapple.

Domaine Louis Moreau Petit Chablis, *Burgundy, France*

Petit Chablis is a fresh and very aromatic wine. Its fruity nose carries a suggestion of apple and citrus notes. In the mouth, a nice gustatory attack is combined with a round and fine palate.

Marquis De Goulaine 'Le Champ Des Vignes' Pouilly Fumé, *Loire, France*

Full of expression, with floral notes; slightly vegetal. The palate is fresh on the attack with chive, white asparagus and flint notes, full-bodied and fleshy; it evokes the fruity, slightly exotic character already revealed in the aromas.

ROSÉ

Quintessence Côtes de Provence, *Côtes de Provence, France*

Pale pink hue with shades of purple and very expressive and exuberant on the nose. Deliciously tangy on the palate with fresh fruit and citrus peel aromas leading to a very elegant finish.

Minuty Côtes De Provence, *Provence, France*

A superb classic of Provence, with its delicately nuanced strawberry fruit, minerality and savoury spice length. A rosé to savour.

DESSERT

Dulong Prestige Sauternes, *Bordeaux, France*

Very lovely straw yellow colour. The nose is of a unique richness mixed with the subtle combination of citrus, fruits, spices, white flowers and honey.

Elysium Black Muscat, *California, USA*

Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.

RED

Jean Balmont Premium Pinot Noir, *Languedoc, France*

A light to medium body wine with wonderful aromas of small red fruits, spices, and vanilla. Light garnet in colour, a traditional characteristic of Pinot Noir.

Bruno Andreu Les Prunelles Merlot, *Pays d'Oc, France*

Clear deep purple colour, fresh strawberry fruits with a good freshness.

Rewild Malbec, *Mendoza, Argentina*

Ripe red fruits, smoke and chocolate all show on the forward and intense nose.

Trulli Lucale Primitivo Apassimento, *Puglia, Italy*

Lucale is intense garnet red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak ageing adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

Altitudes Carmenere Reserva, *Central Valley, Chile*

Intense purple with notes of rosemary and red pepper with chocolate and tobacco aromas. Medium structure with pleasant acidity and juicy red fresh fruit at the finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Domaine La Baume, *Languedoc, France*

A bouquet of fresh ripe dark fruit like blackberry and blackcurrant, blending subtly with notes of wood and coffee beans. In the mouth fresh dark fruit with notes of blackcurrant leaf, followed by structured tannins and a lengthy finish.

Domaine Eyverine Organic Côtes du Rhône, *Rhône, France*

Generous, strong, warm and absolutely pleasant. Sustained by rich and melted tannins and a smooth sensation.

Bottle **£36.00**

Senorial Rioja Crianza, *Rioja, Spain*

A bright, juicy, refreshing medium-bodied red with a fruit-led palate of damson, cranberry, bramble and cherry. Soft and easy-drinking with a whisper of spice on the finish.

Bottle **£37.00**

Chateau des Combes St Emilion Grand Cru, *Bordeaux, France*

A powerful fruity and spice laden nose leads to a supple, well-proportioned palate featuring cherry jam and mocha in the flavour profile, very well made.

Domaine Chartreuse Chateauneuf du Pape, *Rhône, France*

This wine with a ruby colour, offers a frank nose, marked by notes of olive, graphite and candied black fruits. On the palate it is silky and gourmet.

SPARKLING

Cortestrada Prosecco, *Veneto, Italy*

Quite an exuberant nose of yellow plums, banana, nectarine and apple. A fruity, flavourful style with a honeysuckle finish

The Grange, *Alresford, England*

The nose shows ripe red berry fruits - wild strawberry and cherries - overlaid with heady summer florals all held in a soft and bready frame.

Taittinger Brut Reserve City Lights, *Champagne, France*

Pale yellow colour with shimmering highlights and fine mousse. The nose is subtle with aromas of white blossom and ripe fruit, with notes of yellow peaches and dried apricots. The palate is soft and fresh.
